Trieste (Italy), Herring (Denmark), and Riga (Latvia).

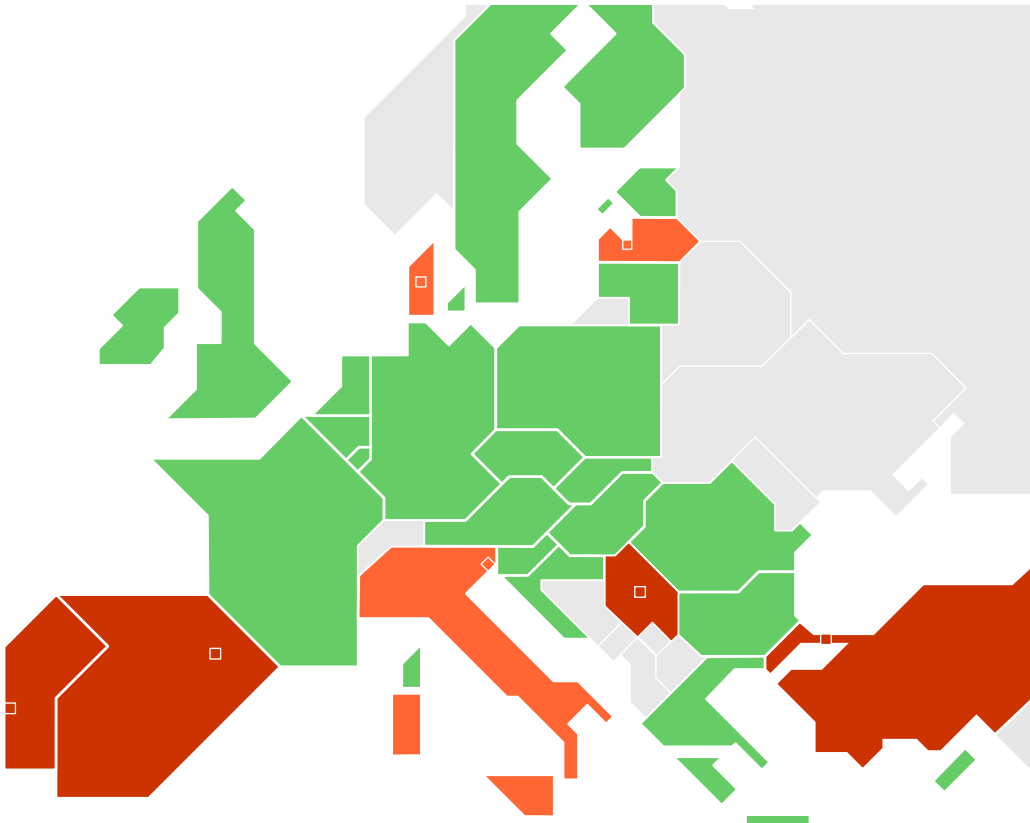
These districts will serve as demonstrators, showcasing energy-efficient buildings, low-carbon mobility options, smart grids, and efficient water and waste management systems.
